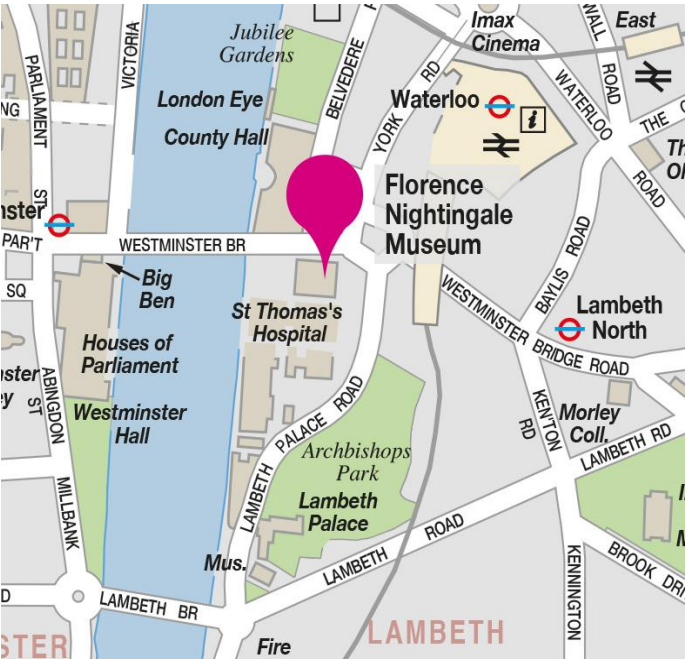

Full day (10am-5pm) £3,000 +VAT; excl. catering

Half day (4 hours) £2,000 +VAT; excl. catering

Evening (6.30-10.30pm) £800 +VAT; excl. catering

Monday's at the Museum

On select Monday's at the museum we are able to offer special day rates.

These rental times are ideal for workshops, lectures, and out of office days. With a variety of options for seating and a projector available for presentations, the space offers a perfect blend of history, charm, and practicality.

Morning Slots (available before 2:30pm)
£650 + VAT; excl. catering

Afternoon Sessions (available between 2:30pm – 5:30pm) £550 +VAT; excl. catering

Please note that sessions within the above allotted times are flexible and can be changed based on need. Prices above include up to 3-hour time slots.

Alcoholic beverages can only be served after 5:00pm.

Venue Hire Add-On's

Museum Tour - £80.00

This tour is provided by a member of the museum team. The tour guide will tell the story of Florence Nightingale's life and point out significant objects around the museum. The tour will last between 25-30 minutes.

Florence Nightingale Tour - £140.00

This tour is led by a costumed actor dressed as Florence Nightingale. Nightingale will take the group through the museum, talking about her life and pointing out significant objects. The tour will last between 25-30 minutes.



Performative Florence Nightingale or Mary Seacole Talk - £140.00

A costumed actor dressed as Florence Nightingale or Mary Seacole will talk about her life and interact with the audience. The talk lasts approximately 30 minutes.

Object Handling Session £60.00

This handling session will be conducted by a member of staff. Guest will have the ability to learn about different areas in history, while getting to hold and interact with artifacts from the museum's handling collection.

Insurance

If you are using private caterers, musicians or entertainers for your event we will require a copy of their public liability insurance and may also require to see copies of any necessary certificates relating to equipment being brought onsite.

Getting here

The Museum is a short walk from Waterloo tube/station and Westminster tube. We are located in the grounds of St Thomas' Hospital (on the corner of Westminster Bridge and Lambeth Palace Road) and you can reach us via the pavement to the hospital car park level.

Parking

Accessibility

Our museum is fully accessible. Exhibitions are all laid out on one floor with no stairs on site or leading to the museums. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to reach out. The full accessibility information is available on our website.

Wheelchair Access

The Florence Nightingale Museum is all on ground floor level and is fully wheelchair accessible.

Toilets

The museum has male toilets, female toilets and an accessible toilet. Both male and female toilets include baby change tables.

Assistance Animals

Working guide and assistance animals are welcome at the museum.

Seating

There is permanent bench seating around the gallery and foldable chairs you are welcome to move around with you, please ask a member of staff if you require assistance.

Subtitles

All video content in the gallery is subtitled. Transcriptions of audio are also available at the entrance of the gallery.
